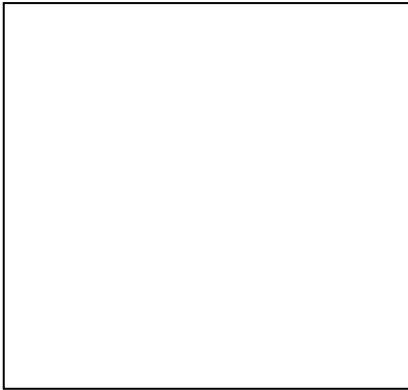


## HOW TO SPOT A TROUBLED CHILD

- Preoccupation, inability to concentrate



- Reluctance, through fear to attempt work
- Fear of mixing with other children
- Aggression to others
- Tendency to be bullied
- An inability to follow routines



- Clinginess and needing constant reassurance
- Contrived helplessness
- Cheating, lying and stealing
- Tendency to destroy work on completion  
attempts to destroy other children's work



- Rejection of adults offer of help
- Acting the clown
- Reluctance to state choices or to agree targets
